4: STALL RENTAL COMMITMENT: The size of each stall is approximately 10 feet wide by 10 feet deep (as space provides). Vendors to supply their own tables. **Service animals only** will be permitted. Designated walkways must be kept clear. Multiple stalls can be purchased. By checking the options below, you are committing to your indicated market dates for seasonal vendors or all dates indicated for daily vendors. Vendors are required to remain until closing time. **Cancellations require a 24-hour notice and can be rescheduled.** Three no-shows without **24-hour notice will forfeit vendor space and fees are <u>not</u> refundable.**

There is not reserved parking for vendors, and you are asked to relocate your vehicle after unloading to allow priority parking for patrons. Parking for the Grand River Farmers Market will be first come, first serve in public parking lots. General rules of parking must be followed at all times. By signing below, I certify that I have read, understand, & will adhere to all applicable guidelines as stated in the **Downtown Jackson Grand River Farmers Market Operating Guidelines**.
